Why volunteer with Dalkeith CAB?

Volunteering for the CAB is a rewarding experience and great opportunity to gain knowledge, experience and skills, while giving something back to the community. It involves:

Meeting new people from a wide range of backgrounds, differing ages and life experiences, with varied outlooks, needs and circumstances.

Gaining new skills and knowledge is a crucial part of volunteering. This can be related to the specific role (e.g. benefits, debt, admin, social media, etc.) Some of these can lead to recognised qualifications. All roles involve developing valuable transferable skills for customer care, effective communication and engaging with people from all walks of life.

Building confidence. Volunteering gives the chance to try something new, interact with others, be part of a team and gain a real sense of achievement that can help with gaining confidence.

Being part of the community by finding out about organisations and activities within the local area.

New challenges. Challenge yourself to do something different while gaining support from colleagues in the team. By setting goals and applying new skills, you may discover talents you didn't realise you had!

Making an impact. The time and care you give will make a positive difference in local people and communities. The CAB's holistic, free, impartial, confidential, quality-assured service is a lifeline for many who are isolated, vulnerable and facing challenges.

What roles are available?

This is a sample of roles often available at Dalkeith CAB. Others arise from time to time. Tell us about your skills, experience and interests and we will try to find the right role for you!

Advisers

They provide face to face, telephone or online advice and information to clients on a range of issues including benefits, debt, home energy savings, employment and housing. The training to become an adviser takes about 3 months.

Administration

This involves tasks like photocopying and scanning documents, updating rotas and appointment schedules, entering data into electronic recording systems, and similar admin activities.

Reception

Volunteer receptionists answer phones, open and sort emails and post, greet clients and show them to appointments.

Social Policy

The CAB collects information on issues clients bring that may have implications for policy at a national level. Social Policy volunteers identify and report information to Citizens Advice Scotland, the national network for bureaux.

Trustee Board
